

Services to Support



Advancing Innovation, Diversity, and Equity in Employment: Career Fair

Featuring speakers, regional and municipal partners, and 36 job booths, the Career Fair in March 2023 supported over 450 job seekers. The Library hosted a booth and provided spaces for workshops and interviews, while highlighting employment resources available for free with a Library card.



A Program On Just About Everything

In 2023, the Library hosted over 400 programs that were designed to support customer financial, physical, social, and mental well-being. These included features such as Bibliotherapy, Money Matters series, Learn to Camp, and Seniors Centre Without Walls programs.



Connecting Social Services

Ajax Public Library offered space to community organizations to create new access points for customers and residents. These services supported housing, financial resources, harm reduction, legal clinics, transit, and employment help.

Expanded Hours

In October 2023, the Library extended hours to open at 9 a.m., Monday through Saturday. This small change had big impact, providing access to space and services sooner.
